The poster presents long term, data-based experience of the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Program, that was launched by the Hungarian Government in 2013 to promote the internationalization of Hungarian higher education and to attract international students from all around the world.




The program has significantly raised the inbound degree mobility and that has been accompanied by factors such as the quality improvement of higher education, intensification of HE cooperation with international partner organizations.




Share of international students and Stipendium Hungaricum students 2013–2023



Percentage of international students per total number of students




Increasing number of study programs in the framework of Stipendium Source: Higher Education Information System



Increasing number of Stipendium Hungaricum students, 2015–2024


